



Governor's SED committee meeting, 21.10.16

Meeting attended by KB, JT, DS, SE, KR. YC

'Perspective' booklet is useful to follow progress of individual children.

Progress is the most important judgement.

EYSF to end Y2 is to be focussed upon.

Targets set at 70%

JT to forward SIA 'crib' sheet to governors

KB to forward summary data document to governors.

2015/16 Y6 cohort history discussed. 7 children did not attend her for KS1.

KR suggested that data relating to 13 PP children needed to be analysed.

JT described action taken throughout the school in response to Maths results.

Maths - significantly lower than similar schools but not below floor standards

Test situation proved difficult for some children. This has been addressed -

- More experience of reasoning & problem solving

- Regular testing

- Staff training

- Moderation and monitoring

- Observing good practice in other schools in the Federation

- Developing links with schools outside Wirral (Burtonmore Wood)

'Rising Stars' scheme is being followed.

Children are being encouraged/taught how to reason why answers may be wrong. Use of jottings is being encouraged.

KB emphasised that progress NOW is key. The picture is strong.

All children's workbooks have been kept as evidence
