Half-term homework task - Year 2

This half term, we have been learning to write instructions and we have also been writing letters. For your homework task this week, you can either:

- create a spell for a witch or wizard and write out the ingredients and instructions

Or:

- read a Julia Donaldson book and write a letter to our class, telling us what the book is, what is good about it, which part was your favourite and why we should read it next half term

Remember to think about the audience you are writing for and the features of the text we have learnt, so

- instructions should include 'bossy verbs'; each step should begin on a new line; you should try to include time conjunctions (*now, then, finally, etc*)
- letters should be set out as practised in class, include the address of the writer, begin '*Dear.....*' and end with the name of the sender

You also have an 'Active Maths' challenge to try (click the link on our webpage to download the instructions) and your Fast 5 or Super 7 words to practise.

We have been asked to think about an item that we would include in our Time Capsule, it should be an item that we feel reflects life today for a Year 2 child. Over the half term, think about what we could choose for our item and discuss it at home. Share your ideas when we come back to school.
