New Kitchen arrangements

Today we finally took control of the school kitchen and served the first new school lunches. They looked incredible and the children gasped when they saw what was on offer. To give you a 'taster' take a look:



The children now have an extended Deli bar (pictured) and as you can see there is a huge range of fillings to choose from. The picture only shows part of the Deli bar! The main hot meal today was pizza. The pizza was all cooked from scratch and even the tomato sauce base was homemade! Tomorrow the main meal is homemade meatballs. Safety online

Sadly, it seems to be the 'modern' way that more and more children are accessing online sites and forums from a younger age. This places those children at risk. Do you know if your child is safe online? Today Mr Klausen spoke to the whole school in assembly about this problem and he shared with the children the ages you need to be to access certain online sites. For example, did you know that you must be at least 13 years of age to use Instagram? Shockingly, quite a few children in the school are using Instagram. The children seemed quite shocked at some of the age restrictions on these sites. To help you guide your children and keep them safe online, the presentation Mr Klausen gave the children has been added to the school website in the e safety /parents section.



I urge you to look at all the information about e safety on the school website with your child - it will help you to keep them safe.

School Uniform

Over the past few months we have had requests from parents to supply backpacks. This we can now do and they are priced at £8 each. A sample is in the school office for you to view.

Some of the children have asked me several times over the past couple of years, if they can have a school tie - both girls and boys! I am happy to add this as an option if there is demand for it. As this is optional it would mean that your child does not have to wear it if they do not want to! The initial design for a tie is quite expensive so we need to assess if the demand for one exists. If demand is good, the price per tie would be £5 and the tie would be the clip on type...not on an elastic. To help decide if we should go ahead in adding this as an option to the uniform please complete the form below and return it to the school office.

New Technology

We have begun the next stage our IT investment for the children. It is hard to keep up with all the changes! Each class now has 5 tablet machines and more will be added to each class set in April. These tablets will be used alongside the laptops and ipads in school to help enhance the children's learning experiences.

On this day we are asking the children to come to school dressed as a character from a book...I'm sure the staff will join in too! On Friday 13th March it is Red Nose Day.
