Dear children and families,

Welcome back to school after the summer break. We have come back to several swimming pools in the area - did we even have a summer?

I am going to keep this letter short and will send a full newsletter next week. An important date for you to remember is Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September. This is the day that the class teachers are holding their classes meetings where they will give you information on what is happening in the class. Please come along at either 9.00am or 5.00pm to this meeting.

During the meeting, the staff will be talking to you about the class routines and how you can help your children throughout this year. Every parent/Guardian will also be given a pack to take home for their child/ren. This pack contains equipment you can use at home to help your child with homework or extra work. It also contains your child's passwords for the online accounts the school holds. One of the links will be for our new online reading resource 'Bug Club'. This online resource will be used in school and you can use it at home with your child too. Homework tasks may be set using this online resource, just as we do with 'MyMaths' (if this is new to you, do not worry, all will be explained at the meetings!). The teaching staff will show you how 'Bug club' operates and how you can access it at home during the meetings. Please note that packs can only be handed to parents/Guardians at the meetings. If you cannot make the meeting dates, you need to contact the school office to arrange to come and collect your pack and have a brief explanation of its contents from a member of staff.

Finally, please remember that if your child arrives at school after 8.55am, you will need to wait with them in the main entrance area, as the first lesson of the day will have started (basic maths). When the lesson finishes at 9.10am they can enter the classroom as they will not be disturbing the learning of the other children. Your child won't miss out on the lesson they have missed as the work will be sent home for them to do that night with you.

Let's all pull together and make this a great term for the children!
