DS chaired the meeting. KB took the minutes.

Minutes of the last meeting and matters arising - Read and agreed

KB needs to set up the kitchen meetings committee jointly with Stanley Governors.

KB attended a meeting at Stanley School regarding the new build, she fed back from that meeting.

SES (Self Evaluation Summary).

KB presented the new 5 page SES. The updated school priorities from the SSP have been included. This was written as a result of last week's Whole School Review. A discussion was held.

Feedback from Whole School Review

This was covered in the Curriculum and Pastoral meeting. The SED reported that the event was useful. In the event of an OFSTED it would be useful to text as well as call SED members. KB has added this to the staff OFSTED guidance document for the admin staff to action on receiving the call.

Headteachers report

This was shared.

Year 2 and year 6 predicted levels

This data was shared - it is a very positive picture in terms of levels. Hard pressed group - this was discussed.

Master tracking document

Governors asked -

1. How are the staff finding the new curriculum? A discussion was held about the impact on standards in KS1 and KS2 and how they differ. The depth of teaching is more important in this curriculum.
2. Why are KS1 outcomes looking better than KS2 outcomes? - this was discussed.
3. Is this new curriculum demanding more time for teachers? - yes, but there is enjoyment and the pupils are responding well especially in maths.
4. How are you addressing mastery in maths? Examples were given of this - the new tab system was explained.

JT explained that Wirrals Maths consultants were coming into school and a further discussion about master will be held with them

BSQM / Whole School Review

These documents were discussed.

The committee looked at these documents once again.

Nursery admissions - Sept 2017

A strategic discussion was held as to whether the school could cope with increase numbers if the proposed 30 hours offer was made to F1 pupils. On balance it was felt the school was in a favourable position to accommodate this.

Strategic plan 2015 2016

The priorities for the years have been re worded and the targets made more measurable.

To ensure a whole school approach to GAPS teaching so ensuring attainment at ARE and ARE+ is at least 85% for all pupils and that HA pupil % increases to at least 50% at 2A+ and 5C+ in years 2 and 6
To raise attainment in writing ensuring attainment at ARE and ARE+ is at least 85% for all pupils and that HA pupil % increases to at least 50% at 2A+ and 5C+ in years 2 and 6
To raise attainment in maths ensuring attainment at ARE and ARE+ is at least 85% for all pupils and that HA pupil % increases to at least 50% at 2A+ and 5C+ in years 2 and 6
