
Dear Potential Sponsor,

RULES

Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets.

Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be returned on or before Thursday 2nd March 2017.

1. **Preschoolers and young school children** - NO rules just have fun, pick it up off the floor! and carry on. Help them as much as is required.
2. **Years 1 - 4** - The pancake has to leave the pan. They are allowed 1 drop of the pancake on the floor before the 1 minute is up. If they drop it more than once the turn is over.
3. **Years 5 & 6** – The pancake has to leave the pan and it must flip over. Once they drop it they are out.
4. On Flip a Pancake Day, each class will try to flip **A COLD pancake** as many times as they can during the specified time period of 1 minute. Each full flip will count.
5. Pledges may be made by anyone. However, participants may not ask for pledges from any of the staff members of **PENSBY PRIMARY PANCAKE FLIP**. **Please ask everyone who pledges if their company has a matching gift fund policy.** Companies who do match pledge gifts need to be listed on the back of the pledge sheet.
6. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per flip, or maximum pledge.** Students may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.
7. Upon completion of the flipathon A member of staff will record each student's flip total on their pledge sheet and return it. Students may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with the money to PENSBY PRIMARY PANCAKE FLIP no later than Thursday 2nd March 2017.**
