New Schools Collaboration

Those families, who have been with us at Pensby Primary for some time, will know that we have collaborated as a soft federation with 5 local schools. This Federation was known as the South Deeside Primary School Federation. It was a very successful working partnership and brought many benefits for everyone.

The landscape and needs for schools has been rapidly developing over the years and it is now known that the most successful collaborations need at least 10 to 12 schools to work together. So, I am very excited to let you know that we now are part of a newly formed Collaboration of 15 schools called Wirral Schools Collaboration. This new Collaboration includes 10 schools in the Deeside area of Wirral and some schools from other areas of Wirral too. We have always worked with our Deeside school cluster as well as the old Federation, so we already know them well and enjoy a very positive professional relationship. We do know the schools who work in other areas of Wirral, but perhaps not quite so well. Working with them is bringing us the experience of working with a much wider and diverse group of schools, with much to offer where perhaps we had been lacking.

This new Collaboration is meeting weekly and in a short space of time we have achieved a massive amount for our schools. For example, we have set up a Deputy Head cluster group, a SENCo cluster, we have organised an online INSET day in January and we have identified a range of staff in our schools who are experts in certain subject fields who can support us.

I will bring you more news of the new collaboration and how it continues developing – it really is an amazing time to work together like this.

Parent's evenings

In the last online meeting of the new collaboration, the head teachers discussed our upcoming parent's evenings and how these would be held.

Whilst every school favoured face to face meetings, it was clear that with the rise in COVID cases nationally and locally this was something we had to take into account. The closure or part closure of some local schools, due to the numbers of staff with COVID was the biggest concern – we want most of all to keep our schools fully open over the autumn term so every child can attend.

With this in mind the collaboration schools will not be holding face to face parents meetings this term and will move to online or phone call appointments. In Pensby we will offer a phone call and details of how to book your calls with teachers will be sent out next week.

We will still hold the evening to view your children's books (Tuesday 12th October) as we can offer better distancing for you. It is important you see your children's work and that you share this special event with your child. More details about how we will support this will be sent home.

PTA support

This term the PTA will be organising raffles. Do you have or can you access a suitable prize for one of the raffles?
