Friday – 1 Vacancy

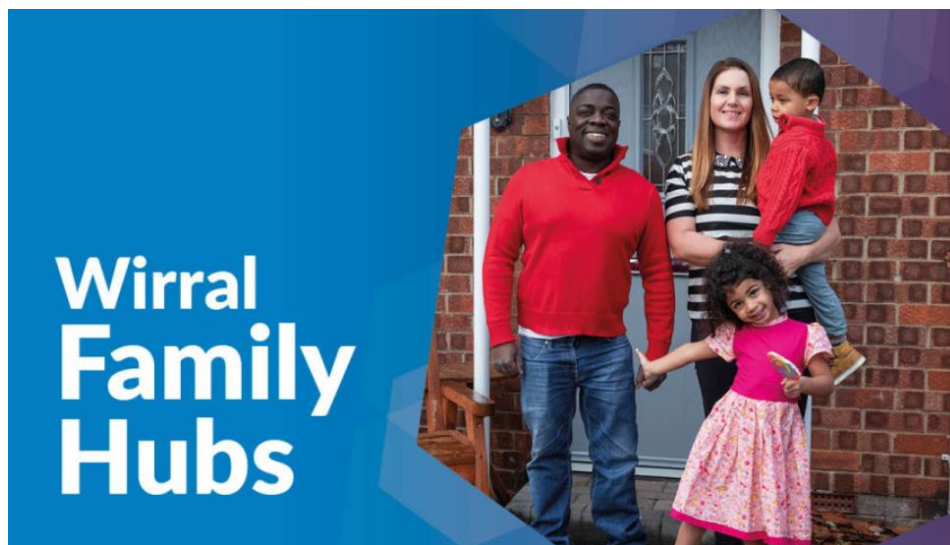
