We have two vacancies for new joint roles of Kitchen Assistant and Midday Assistant.

Vacancy 1 - Kitchen Assistant/ MDA -17.5 hours in total over 5 days

10.00am to 12.00pm Kitchen Assistant,
12.00 to 1.00pm as Midday Assistant,
1.00pm to 1.30pm as Kitchen Assistant.

1.00pm to 1.30pm as Kitchen Assistant.

This is 3.5 hours per day or 17.5 hours per week. This role is for a September start. If you are interested, please email into the school office and we will send you further information. The closing date for applications is Wednesday 12th July and interviews will be held shortly after that.

School meals, milk and toast prices

In school we do not look to make a profit but we do need to cover our costs. The governors have looked carefully at school meals, toast and milk prices as costs for these have increased significantly. All year we have resisted passing an increase on to families. After much work, they have decided that in September the prices of the above items will be;

School Meal - £2.50 per day
Milk – 20p per day
Toast – 30p per day

These prices have been compared to other schools and are in line or lower than the majority of schools.
