



Parking-positives and negatives!

Thank you to all the families who have been using the drop off as requested. This really has helped the traffic to flow through the site. Sadly, the parking outside the main school gates has not been so wonderful. This photograph was sent in to me with an email stating quite rightly that this parking is 'dangerous and inconsiderate to our children and neighbours'. To save the blushes of the owner I have on this occasion blocked the number plate. However, those of you who have been here a while will know that this will not always be the case!





The single yellow lines outside the school entrance and exit are like the ones above and detail when no parking or dropping off or collecting should take place. Parking on those lines at this time, is inconsiderate and dangerous to our children and if a parking attendant is in the area will attract a £70 parking fine.
