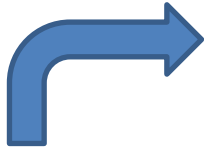


Autumn Term 2023 – Overview of F1 Curriculum



Literacy

- Lots and lots of Nursery Rhyme singing!
- Share ideas about books read to them
- Give meaning to their mark-making
- Sound discrimination activities

Personal and Emotional Development

- To become familiar with the routines and expectations of the Nursery day and manage transitions with increasing confidence
- To develop friendships with other children



Mathematics

Focus on numbers 1-3

- Counting, representing, subitising, link numerals to amounts, compare quantities, finding 1 more and 1 less
- Talk about patterns around them

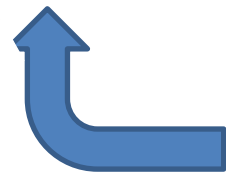
Communication and Language

- Listen to a range of stories, including Going on a Bear Hunt and Monkey Puzzle, and understand what is happening
- To listen to and follow simple instructions
- Listen to others during Circle Times, answer simple questions and talk about their own experiences in increasingly detailed sentences



Expressive Art and Design

- Explore colour and colour-mixing
- Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use shape to represent objects
- Develop stories using small world equipment



Physical Development

- Be increasingly independent as they get dressed, putting on coats and shoes.
- Develop preference for hand dominance and a comfortable pencil grip.
- Continue to develop gross and fine motor strength and control



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Begin to make sense of their own life story and family's history
- Learn about different occupations (Doctors, Nurses, Dentists)
- Learn about the seasons and Christmas
