### School Day Timings

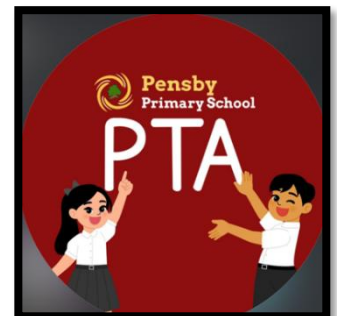


Children can wear their **Christmas jumpers and non-uniform on this day**, but we are not asking for donations for this.

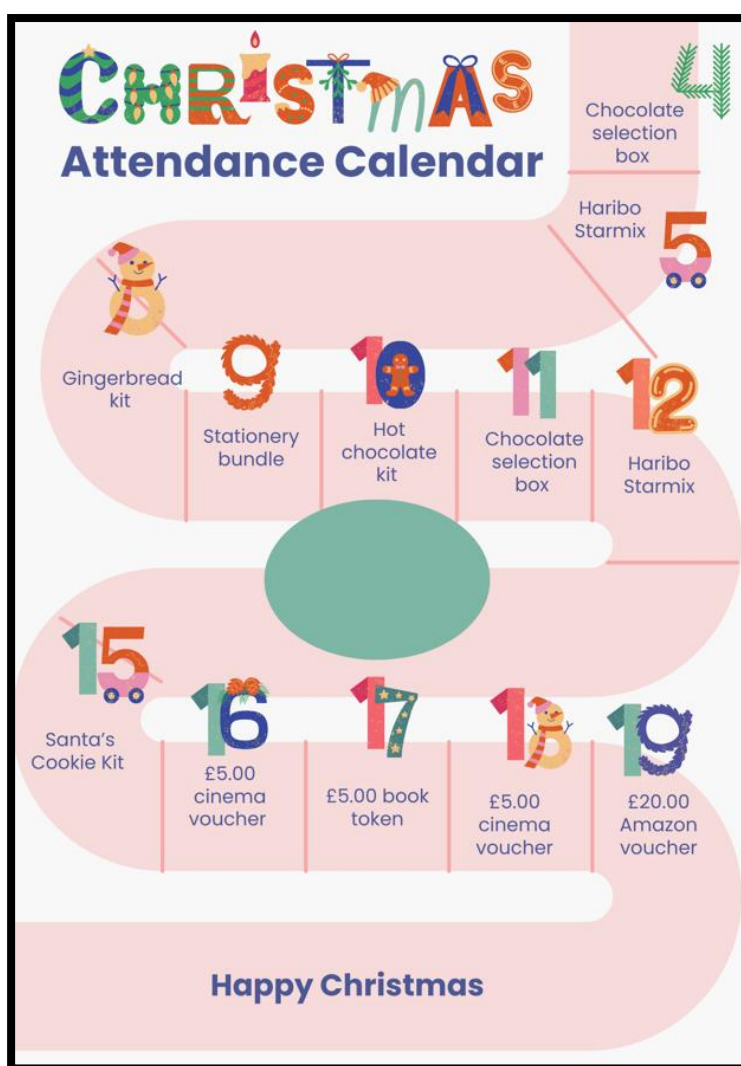
## Key Stage Two Carol Concert 17<sup>th</sup> December at 5:30pm
