### Parents' Evening

A reminder that parents' evening appointments close 24 hours before each session. Please make your bookings via Parent Mail.

At the meeting there will be an opportunity for you to look at your child's books and talk to their class teacher. Please be mindful of the 10-minute allocation whilst meeting with your child's class teacher. This will help to keep the evening running as smoothly as possible.

### Breaktime snacks

Chocolate bars, cereal bars and crisps are not permitted as morning snack items. Only fruit, vegetable sticks such as carrots or cucumbers and toast, either purchased at school or brought in from home, are allowed.

### Water bottles

We would like to remind families that we do not encourage juice in water bottles from home. We have always requested that only water is brought into school and for lunchtime, cartons of juice can be brought in your child's packed lunch. We realise that this rule has not been shared for some time but would appreciate your support by ensuring your child brings water only to school.

We appreciate that in some cases children may prefer juice, but this can usually be adjusted over time. If this would be difficult for your child and there are circumstances that you would like us to be aware of, please speak with your child's class teacher.

### Toys brought in from home

We have noticed that several children have been bringing in Labubu teddies and toys from home. Unfortunately, this often results in the loss or misplacement of these items which in turn causes the children more worry and upset. Please can all toys and teddies remain at home.

### Parking

Parking has become more of an issue with the limited number of parking spaces on site and this is presenting problems for our neighbours and our children's safety.

Please can we all be mindful of the safety of children when crossing nearby roads and be sensible and safe with our parking.

The use of the drop off is an option for older children so please take advantage of this space instead of parking across pavements and driveways.

Poppies will be on sale from **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> October.**

There are no set prices for each item, just a donation. Year 6 children will set up a poppy stall in the atrium each afternoon for children to purchase their poppies and/or other items.

There will also be a selection of goodies and glowsticks all on sale through the night.

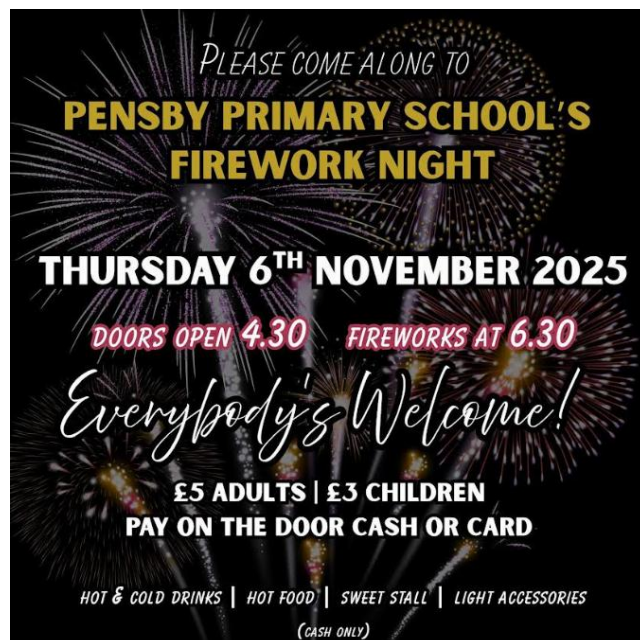
## Cross Country News
